








PRE STUDY

ARRIVAL



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DRESS CODE

Appropriate attire is needed throughout the duration of the course as this is a clinical environment.

You will be expected to:

- Wear flat, sensible, closed-toe shoes
- Wear tunic or salon wear
- Wear leggings/pants
- Have your hair tied back
- Provide your own protective face mask or visor

Failure to do so will put the clients and yourself at risk.





COVID-19 REGULATIONS

Due to the recent outbreak of COVID-19, all students will have their temperature checked upon arrival at our training academy. If you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 you will not be permitted to enter and continue on the course. This is for the protection of everyone.

You will be required to sign a disclaimer to state that you have not experienced a high temperature or any of the following symptoms:

- A high temperature –this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature).
- A new, continuous cough –this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual).
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste –this means you’ve noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different from normal.

All students are to wear a mask or visor during their time at the school.

You will also be required to Track and Trace upon entering the clinic so please ensure you have the NHS Track and Trace App readily installed on your mobile phone ready to participate. You can download the app here: www.covid19.nhs.uk

During lunchtime and refreshment breaks all students are to respect the 1-metre plus social distancing rule and not be any closer to teachers or fellow students.
