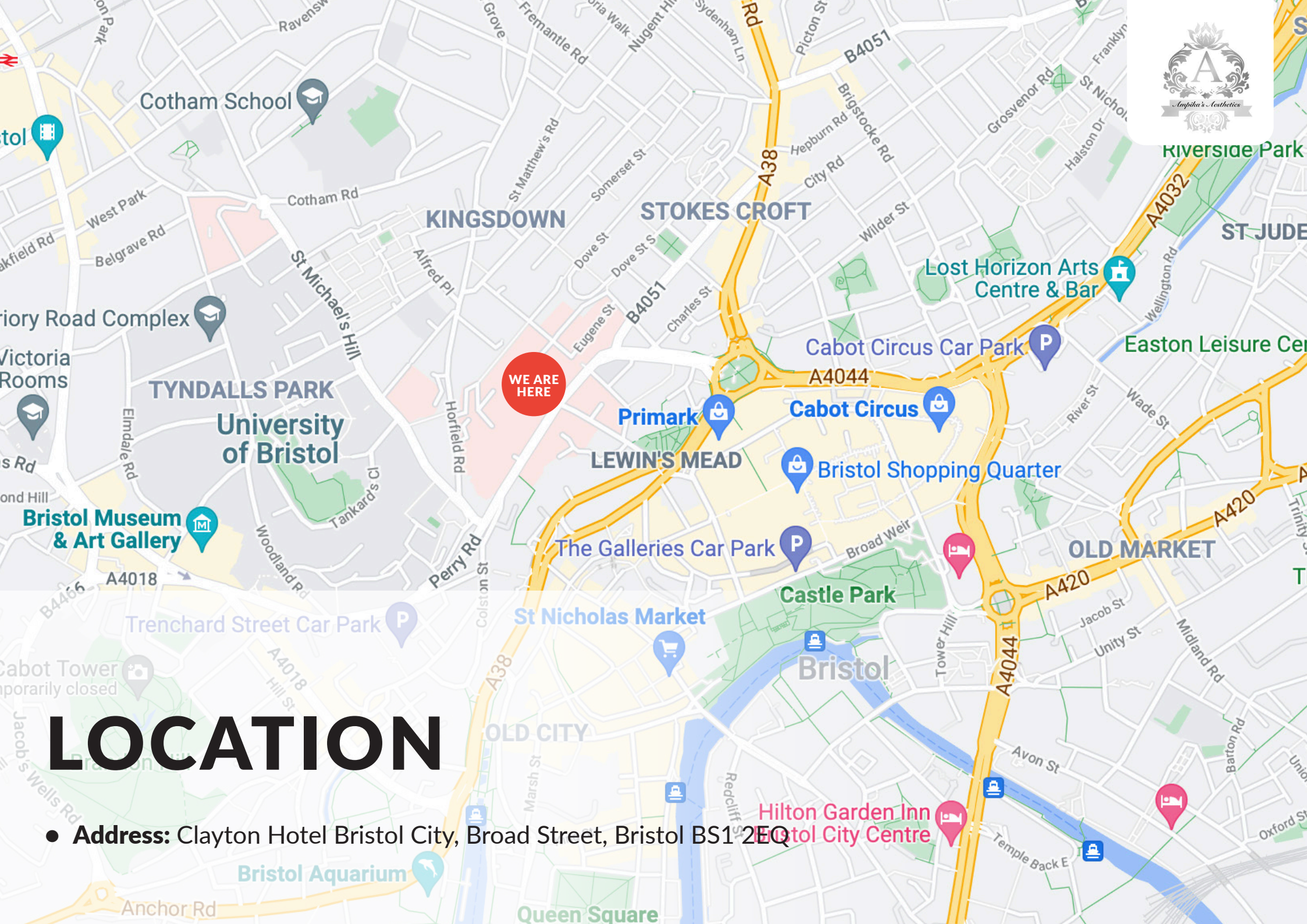


# ARRIVAL

# TRANSPORT

- **Airport Transfers**

A bus service is available for transport from Bristol International airport. Bristol Airport Flyer runs 7 days per week, every 20 minutes. The nearest stop to the hotel is C1 Rupert Street & C2 Anchor Road. The hotel is located 600 yards from the main street.

- **From Bristol Temple meads Train station**

A short 15-minute walk away approx. 0.8 miles. Exit the station onto the station approach road. Turn right onto temple gate. At the next junction follow Victoria Street until you reach Bristol Bridge. After crossing Bristol Bridge follow the high street for approx. 200 yards until it meets Broad Street. The hotel is located at the bottom of Broad Street.

- **Coming from the M4 London**

Take Junction 19 for the M32. Follow the M32 until it meets the A4032 and A4044. Follow this road until the James Barton roundabout, take the 1st exit. Veer left with the road, take the left turn after the old Fire station onto Bridwell Street. Take a left onto Nelson Street, your first right and right again. The entrance to Nelson Street car park will be in front of you.
