






### ARRIVAL

# TRANSPORT

#### • Travelling by Car

From the A1 in any direction, continue to follow until reaching signs for A184 Gateshead/Newcastle (Centre). Take the slip road and continue to follow A184 St James' Road over the bridge. Remain in the left lane. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Scotswood Road and then follow signs for B1600 Quayside, leading onto Railway Street. Continue to follow B1600 for around 1 mile. Once passing under the bridge, the Hotel will be on the right.

#### • Travelling by Train

INNSIDE by Meliá is just an 8 minute walk from Newcastle Train Station on Neville Street. Come out of the station and Turn right onto Neville St/A186. Continue onto Westgate Rd/A186. Turn right onto Clavering Pl. Turn left at the end of the road and you will find the hotel opposite.
