COURSE CONTENT

Our CO2 laser course covers the technology, safety, treatment protocols, and practical application of CO2 lasers for skin resurfacing and other aesthetic procedures. The curriculum often includes both theoretical knowledge and hands-on training with live models, focusing on areas like skin anatomy, laser physics, treatment planning, and complication management.

DRESS CODE

When performing laser treatments as a therapist, you should wear clean, professional clothing, preferably a uniform, and protective eyewear. Loose clothing is recommended to minimise friction, and jewellery and other items that could cause reflections should be avoided.

Clean Uniform:

A professional uniform is essential for maintaining hygiene and creating a positive image, according to the training school's requirements in line with their policies and procedures.

Protective Eyewear:

Laser safety glasses or goggles are crucial to protect your eyes from potential laser exposure. The specific type of eyewear should be chosen based on the laser's classification and the treatment area; this will be provided by the training school.

Loose Clothing:

Loose-fitting clothing on the body areas to be treated can help prevent friction and potential irritation.

No Jewellery or Reflective Items:

Jewellery, hairpins, and other items that could reflect the laser beam should be avoided to prevent accidental exposure.



BEHAVIOUR

Your behaviour, body language and tone of voice are to conform to a positive and professional student manner. The training school has a ZERO tolerance to abuse of any kind.

Recommended Behaviour:

- All bags, outerwear, phones, and personal belongings should be stored in provided lockers/storage areas, unless otherwise arranged with the tutor
- Water is the only drink permitted in sessions
- No other food or drinks are permitted

N.B. We can at times permit a learner to use their phone in the session to take before and after pictures, learners must always maintain a sterile field. Phones should be cleaned when they are brought into the session, gloves are applied after the before pictures and removed before the after pictures.
